

## Post-Masters Certificates in Nursing

Five post-master's certificate tracks are offered, including the Advanced Public Health Nurse Certificate, the Family Nurse Practitioner Certificate, the Nurse Anesthesia Certificate, Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner Certificate, and the Nurse Educator Certificate. The certificate programs are offered to nurses with master's degrees in nursing who are seeking additional career options.

### Certificate in Advanced Public Health Nurse

**Admission Requirements:**

1. Masters degree in nursing.
2. Licensure as a registered nurse.

**Certificate Requirements:** A total of **32 credits** are required for the Advanced Public Health Nurse specialization. The identified courses meet the certification requirements of the American Nurses Credentialing Center. The following are required:

### Certificate in Nurse Anesthesia

**Admission Requirements:**

1. Master's degree in nursing.
2. Licensure as a registered nurse.
3. Additional requirements for Nurse Anesthesia are a baccalaureate degree in nursing, an undergraduate course in biochemistry (**BMB 301** Biochemistry or equivalent), an undergraduate college algebra course (equivalent or higher), one year of critical care nursing experience (two years preferred), and a successful interview.

#### Certificate Requirements

A total of **65-67\* credits** are required for the Nurse Anesthesia Certificate. These courses meet the requirements of the Council on Accreditation for Nurse Anesthesia Educational Programs. The following are required:
